ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Appointment of Head of State and Dissolution of Military Government Decree, I did by the Appointment of Prime Minister Decree appoint you to be the Prime Minister with effect from 5 December, 1987:

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers vested in me as President and Commander-in-Chief of the Republic of Fiji I did further appoint you to be the Minister for Foreign Affairs with effect from 10 December, 1987, and did by directions assign to you responsibility for the business and departments of Government specified in an Assignment under my hand on 28 March, 1988:

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 9 of the Head of State and Executive Authority of Fiji Decree, 1988, and acting in accordance with the advice of, but after consultation with the Prime Minister, I did further appoint you to be the Minister for Home Affairs with effect from 6 January, 1990:

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sub-section (1) of section 14 of the Head of State and Executive Authority of Fiji Decree, 1988, and acting in accordance with the advice of, but after consultation with, the Prime Minister, I did by directions assign to you, with effect from 6 January, 1990, responsibility for the business and departments of Government specified in an Assignment under my hand dated 12 January, 1990 :

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sub-section (1) of section 86 of the Constitution, 1990 and acting in accordance with the advice of, but after consultation with, the Prime Minister, I do by these directions vary the said Assignments by transferring to you, with effect from 29 April, 1992, responsibility for the business and departments of Government hereinafter specified-
